### INTRODUCTION



The Intergovernmental Oceanographic Commission (IOC) is established as a body with functional autonomy within UNESCO to promote international cooperation and to coordinate programmes in marine scientific research, services and capacity-building.



As a regional subsidiary body, the IOC Sub-Commission for the Western Pacific (WESTPAC) was established in 1989, evolving from an IOC regional program. Its main task is to develop and coordinate required regional marine scientific research programmes, ocean observations and services based on priority interests of the Member States in the region and to implement the programmes and activities of the IOC in the regional context.



Since 1994, WESTPAC has its secretariat in Bangkok, Thailand, for which support is kindly provided by the Government of Thailand, through her National Research Council of Thailand (NRCT) during 1994-2005, and Department of Marine and Coastal Resources (DMCR) from 2006.

Encouraged by the success of previous six symposia, the Ministry of Science, Technology and Innovation of Malaysia and IOC/WESTPAC have joined hands to organize the Seventh IOC/WESTPAC International Scientific Symposium entitled **'Natural Hazards and Changing Marine Environment in the Western Pacific'** in May 2008.
